

The Ten Commandments of naturism in liberty



1. You shall learn by heart the definition of "naturism in liberty":
"Naturism is a way of living free, happy and in harmony with nature, characterised by the practice of social nudity, with the aim of encouraging self-respect, respect for others and for the environment" (Definition of the International Naturist Federation, 1974, reviewed and corrected by APNEL in 2007)
2. You shall know, for exemple, how to recite and explain article 222-32 of the French Penal Code : "Sexual exhibition imposed on the sight of others in a place accessible to the view of the public is punishable by one year of imprisonment and of a 15 000 € fine." Simple nudity is evidently no more "sexual" than the wearing of shorts or a skirt. (www.naturismedroit.net)
3. To increase the security and enjoyment of your activity, you shall practice it preferably in a group, and if possible in a mixed group, or better, a family group. You are then less likely to be unjustly accused of sexual exhibitionism.
4. If you encounter a person hostile to the simple sight of a nude body, you shall use psychology and avoid imposing your nudity on him. You shall put on your pareo or little skirt and enter into discussion with him. Remember the french fable "The oak and the reed" by La Fontaine

5. In company with others or in the family, you shall not hesitate to raise the question of nudity.
6. While walking outdoors, carry a bag to collect litter dropped by less aware individuals. When you meet people do not hesitate to mention the subject.
7. While you are picnicing, place two or three signs like: "Welcome to this (provisionally) naturist venue". And if some textiles pass close by, think of offering a "friendly glass" by way of opening communication.
8. You will forcibly remind your detractors that nudophobia is just as absurd as homophobia, racism or mysogeny and thus should be repressed or taken care of by re-education and/or psychotherapy.
9. Be supportive when one of your naked companions is unjustly apprehended.
10. The happiness which naturism in liberty brings will give you the strength of your convictions and the serenity and calmness to express them. Also, in every situation, you will be an enthusiastic ambassador for the complete acceptance of nudity.
